This position gives the opportunity to experience and learn from a nonprofit gardening organization. Duties would include working with garden leaders and volunteers, assisting with a wide range of garden tasks (planting, weeding, watering, pruning, harvesting, etc.), helping coordinate garden groups and family outreach activities, contributing to the team, and other duties as assigned. Training will be provided.
